

Creating your Fresno Pacific Zoom Faculty Account

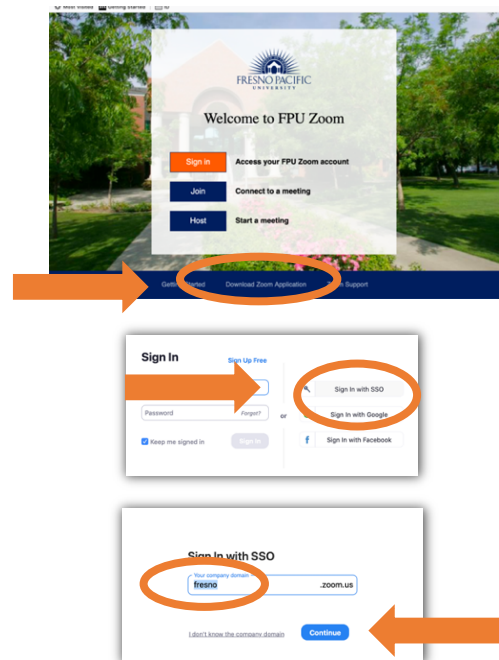
Zoom is a virtual meeting tool that allows faculty and students to meet live in an online space. Faculty licensed accounts **must be requested** through the Center for Online Learning to allow advanced features including unlimited time, recording to Vidgrid, polling, and break-out sessions.

Setting up your account for teaching currently requires three steps.

- 1) Create a basic account using FPU Single Sign On as shown below.
- 2) Contact the Center for Online Learning to request a faculty license.
- 3) Create a Vidgrid account to access and share your Zoom recordings.

1. To create your FPU Zoom account using Single Sign on:

- a. Open the FPU Zoom website
<https://fresno.zoom.us>
- b. Click the Download Zoom Application link at the bottom of the page.
- c. Download the Client for Meetings and follow the prompts to install the application to your computer.
- d. Open the Zoom application from your computer. (It will be in your Programs or Applications folder)
- e. Click the "SSO login" button
- f. Next, type *fresno* for the domain and click the *Continue* button.
- g. You will be asked to login and authenticate using your @fresno.edu email and password as with other FPU systems.



2. **Email the Center for Online Learning at col@fresno.edu to request a Pro licensed faculty account.**
3. **Create a Vidgrid Account.** Zoom cloud recordings are automatically transferred to the FPU video storage system, Vidgrid, where you can edit and share your videos with students.
